Dear Mr. Scott:

It's been a good while since we started feeding the Perma-Guard to 15 calves in our fitting barn. I would very much like to at this time give you a definite opinion on the material, but as you know a short-range effect could be an illusion.

In the control group of cattle we have had two cases of diarrhea and one case of pneumonia. The Perma-Guard fed group has had no diarrhea and no other sicknesses other than an occasional runny nose which both groups have had from time to time. Both groups of calves have excellent coats of hair, but considering the fact that the control group is being fed every possible dietary need, this would be expected.

It's been raining ever since you came down and my scales are at another farm and we have not had the opportunity to check the difference in weight at this time. We will do so in the very near future.

Subject to further tests, which I think should be done on groups of cattle that are not being handled as we normally would show cattle, I believe that the effect of Perma-Guard would without question be more evident.

Until we can further evaluate your product, it is not intent for this letter to be used as a testimonial of your product.
